# 1. Product Disposal (WPC Product)

✓ 100% Recyclable – NewTechWood Wood Plastic Composite (WPC) products are fully recyclable.

#### A How to Recycle:

- Check with your local recycling facility to confirm acceptance.
- If curbside recycling does not take WPC, visit a specialized plastics/composite recycling center.
- Some manufacturers or retailers offer take-back programs—contact us for details.

## 2. Packaging Materials Disposal

✓ All packaging components are 100% or readily recyclable. Follow these steps to ensure proper disposal:

#### A. Plastic Components

- PE (Polyethylene)
  - o Includes: Plastic protective sheets, corner trims, logo-printed film.
  - Disposal: Rinse if soiled, remove adhesives, and recycle with soft/flexible plastics (e.g., grocery store drop-offs, check local guidelines).
  - Where: Curbside (if accepted) or drop off at plastic film recycling bins (e.g., grocery stores).
- PET (Polyethylene Terephthalate)
  - o Includes: Plastic straps.
  - Disposal: Cut straps to avoid tangling machinery; recycle with rigid plastics.

## **B. Wood Components**

- Includes: Joists, fumigated pallets, plywood planks.
- Disposal Options:
  - Reuse: Ideal for DIY projects or return to suppliers.
  - o Recycle: Untreated wood accepted at wood waste facilities or composting centers.
  - Bulky Waste: Some municipalities collect for recycling.



## C. Metal Components

- Includes: Steel/metal pellets (straps).
- Disposal:
  - Separate from other materials.
  - o Recycle at scrap metal facilities or curbside metal bins.

### D. Paper & Cardboard

- Includes: Corrugated cardboard boxes, labels.
- Disposal:
  - o Flatten boxes; remove tape/labels if possible.
  - Recycle curbside or at paper recycling centers.
